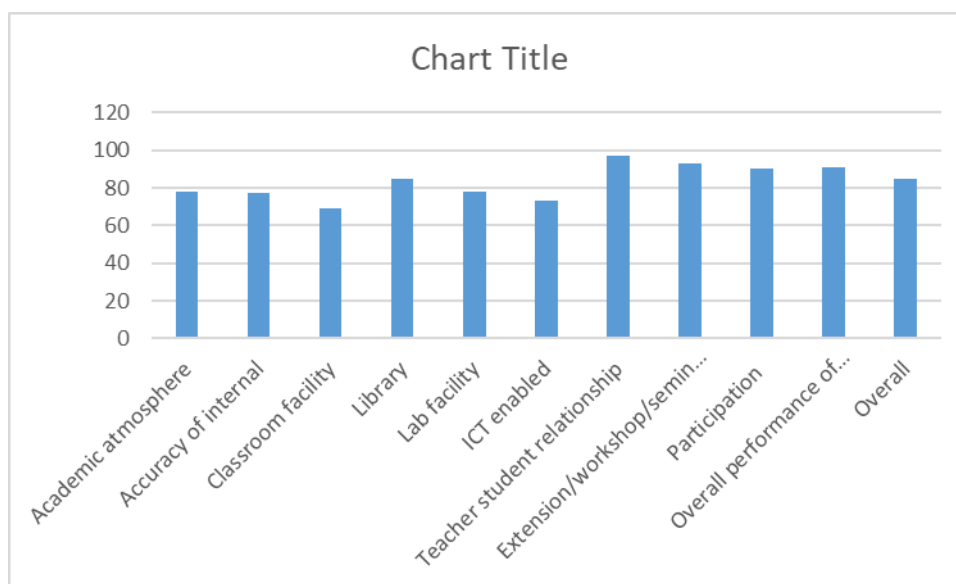


## BSc Physics Fourth Semester - 2018-21 Batch

#### Dept Evaluation

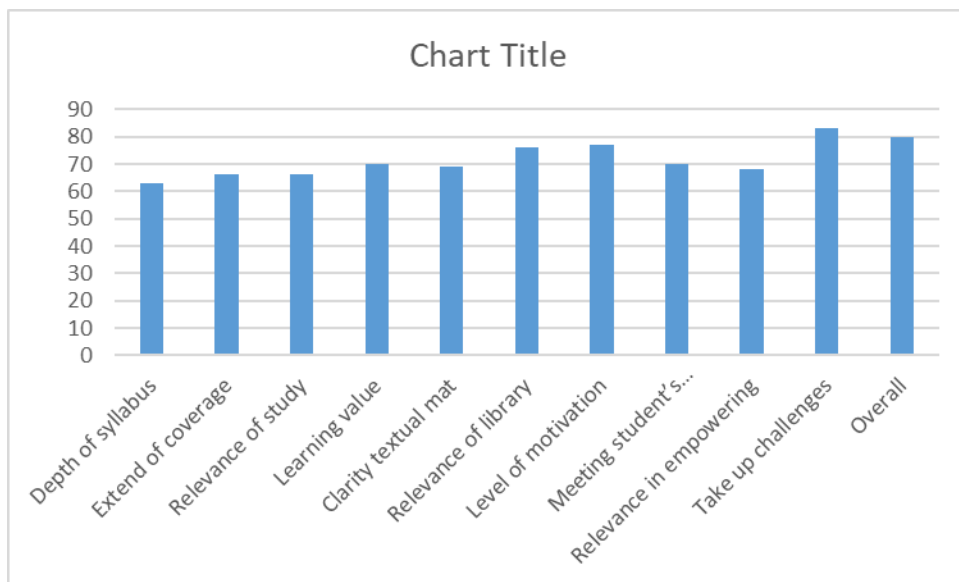

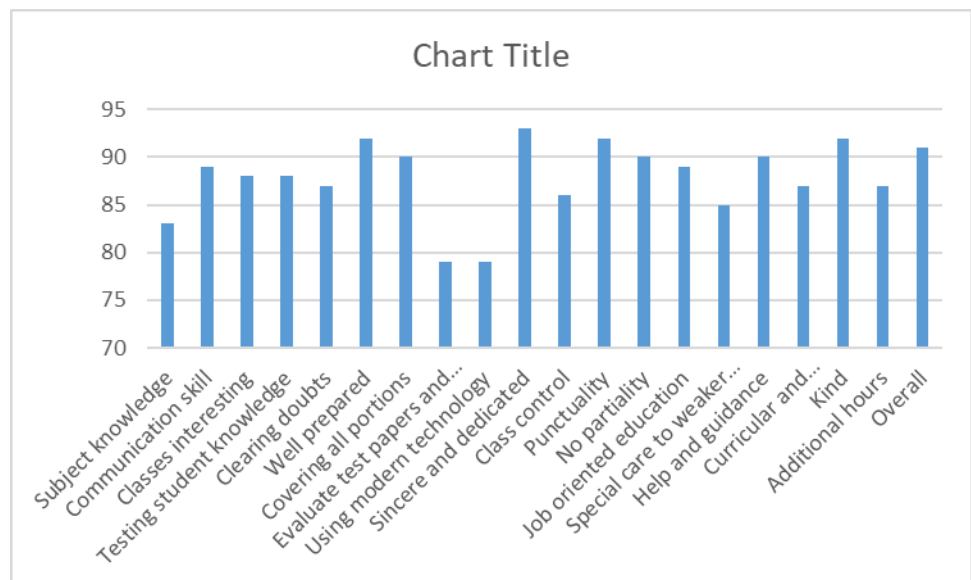
