Webinar on

Early Detection and Management of Breast Cancer"

Cancer is a leading cause of death worldwide. It accounts for 7.4 million deaths (around 13% of all deaths). Cancer creates fear which comes out of ignorance and misconception. More than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying life style or avoiding key risk factors. About 1/3 of cancer cases could be reduced, if cases are treated and detected at an early stage.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. This year it was observed with the theme "Give hope, Save lives". Usually people are asked to show support for breast cancer survivors and those battling the disease, by wearing pink ribbon or clothing. But this year due to COVID 19 and social distancing, this was not possible.

So in this Lockdown, it is highly essential to conduct programmes to inform people about the importance of check up in an early stage. Students, Parents and Teachers form the cross section of the community. Breast cancer awareness programmes are scarce. The webinaraimed at gathering students, teachers, doctors and general public in an online platform; who can be the torchbearersto our society.

Department of Zoology and Health Education Club has jointly organized an Interactive Webinar on a very relevant topic "Early Detection And Management Of Brest Cancer" in association with Regional Cancer Centre, Trivandrum, Kerala and Indian Dental Association, Attingal Branch at 7.00 pm on 20th October, 2020. It was conducted via the Zoom meet.

Aims and Objective:

1) To give awareness and to discuss the stages of reproductive life and the common problems from birth to post-menopause
