#### **Technical Session I**

The first technical session was on "Higher Education Current Scenario" and session was handled by respected Pro- Vice Chancellor of University of Kerala. The resource person talks about the importance and antiquity of education to bring desirable change in our life, especially the higher education and are narrated as below.

In Kerala education expanded very rapidly in the last six decades after independence. There are several people from Kerala around globe that are well known for their potentiality and the good skill and technique. During the time of second five-year plan there were 10079 educational institutions in Kerala, Today Kerala rank first position in literacy among Indian state. Kerala has special care to the development of an education system that is inclusive and universally accessible. In Kerala14 State universities has been functioning. Out of these, four universities namely, Kerala, Mahatma Gandhi, Calicut and Kannur are providing various courses to the students. Kerala has covered a long distance on the institutional capacity in higher education. Kerala higher education system challenge with issues pertaining to quality and in many institutions and universities problems of faculties, poor quality of teaching is common. Today students have been lots of option. The scenario of the classroom has changing. The 21th century is also the age of science and technology. So, ICT play a significant role in the student evaluation. ICT helps the teachers to communicate better way with student. Through ICT pass amount of information to student without a very little time. He concluded that Kerala higher education system holds not only in qualitative terms, but also in quantitative terms. Higher education in Kerala has expanded very rapidly after the thirteenth plan. 



The class was designed to be practical therefore the theoretical knowledge that constitutes research methodology is organized around the operational steps that form the research process for both quantitative and qualitative research. Through this class, researchers and faculties was able to formulate and write research questions, hypotheses and research objectives and are able to effectively select the correct research design. Also, examine critically the importance of a sampling strategy in both quantitative and qualitative research and be familiar with key sampling methods. This class helps the participants the importance to undertake a critical literature review and recognize the strengths and weaknesses in secondary data and to develop robust data collection instruments. The class also gave special emphasis on writing a research proposal that demonstrates an understanding of the research process and the key principles of research ethics. 









### Webinar on Intellectual Property Right



A Webinar on "Intellectual Property rights" was conducted by the IQAC, SNC, Varkala, on 30.05.2022. The programme was started at 07: 00 PM with a silent prayer. Welcome address was delivered by Dr. Soju. S, IQAC Coordinator. Dr. K. C Preetha, Principal, Sree Narayana College, Varkala delivered the inaugural address and the function was attended by more than 50 participants. The resource person Dr. Sanu, Assistant professor, KSM DB College, Sasthamcotta gives an overview of intellectual property right. He points out that IP is the creations of the mind, such as inventions; literary and artistic works; designs; and symbols, names and images used in commerce. His topic covered the different aspects of IPR such as what is the need of protesting ideas, who can file IP and how IP can be protected. The class was very

much informative to the students and helped them to attain an awareness regarding the different concepts on IPR, and its objective. The primary objective of an Intellectual Property Rights is to encourage inventions by promoting their protection and utilization so as to contribute to the development of Industries, which in turn contributes to the promotion of technological innovation and to the transfer and dissemination of technology. Patent is a monopoly right given by the government to an inventor for a period of twenty years. Once granted, a patent gives the inventor the right to exclude others from making, using, selling or offering for a sale of the inventor's invention for the duration specified in the terms of patent. After twenty years the patent falls under public domain there after anyone can use the invention without permission from patentee. Invention can be any new article, composition of matter, machine, process or any new value addition to the above said.
