21st Century Skills: For Learners and Job Seekers

In Modern Days, a skills gap exists across an entire generation of workers. If that gap isn't addressed, it could have dire consequences for the new global economy. 21st-century learning is more than just the 3Rs (reading, writing, and arithmetic). It emphasizes the importance of critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication – skills essential for students to thrive in the 21st century.

How to Plan your Career Search

It is important to explore careers that interest each person in society. It is key to find out what skills the candidates need to succeed, the salary he/she can expect to earn, and the career outlook. There are many ways to find a new job such as Networking, Referrals, Job Boards and Career Websites, Job Fairs, Company Websites, Cold Calling, Headhunters and Recruiters, Temping or Internships and so on.

Mastering Group Discussions: Types and Techniques

Placement Grooming is important in filling the gap between academics and the corporate world. By placement grooming, institutions can emphasise the technical and non-technical aspects of pre-placement training. This will enable students to crack job interviews and ace the recruitment process
