The forum is intended to mould the students to involve in various activities like open discussions, debates and seminars of current social and political issues of the State or nation.

The activities of the club started with talk delivered by the co-ordinator Smt.Sreerenjini.S.C on 23/09/2019. The function started with prayer by Aswathy, 2nd year economics student. Smt. Anila Kumary. R (Assistant Professor, Dept of Economics) delivered the welcome speech. Presidential Address was rendered by Smt.Joly.A (Principal, S.N.College, Varkala).In her speech she stressed the importance of a well-disciplined social life. The talk was on the topic "Role of Planning in personal life". The Speaker emphasized the importance of planning and organization in one's life.
