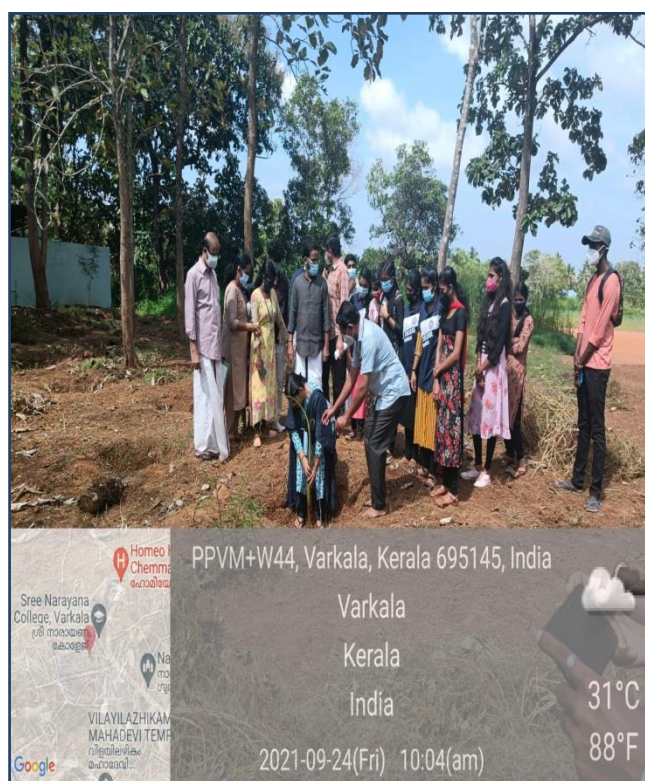
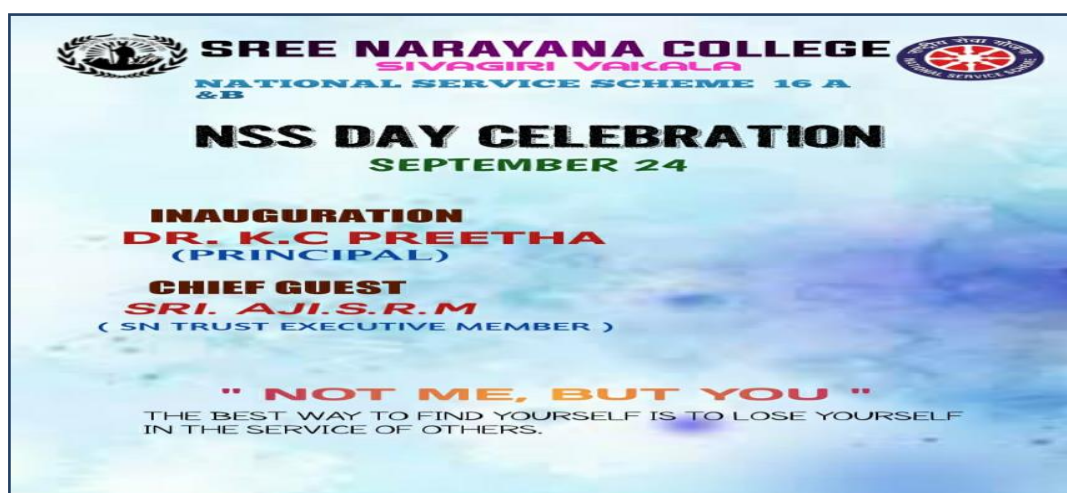

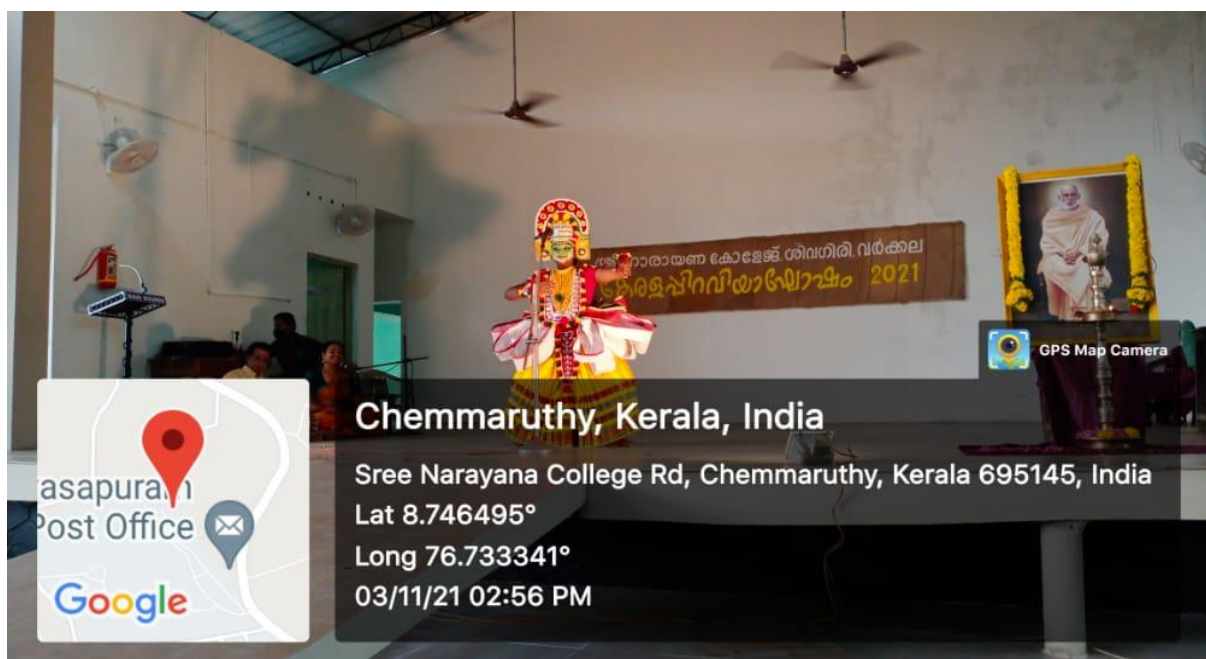
## Gandhi Jayanthi

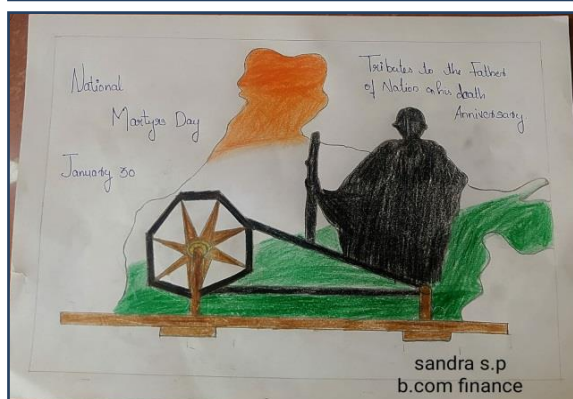
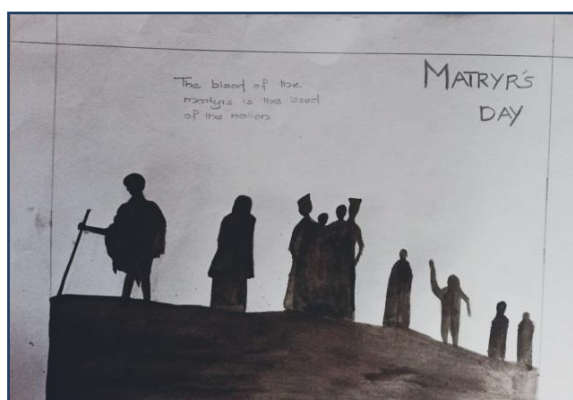
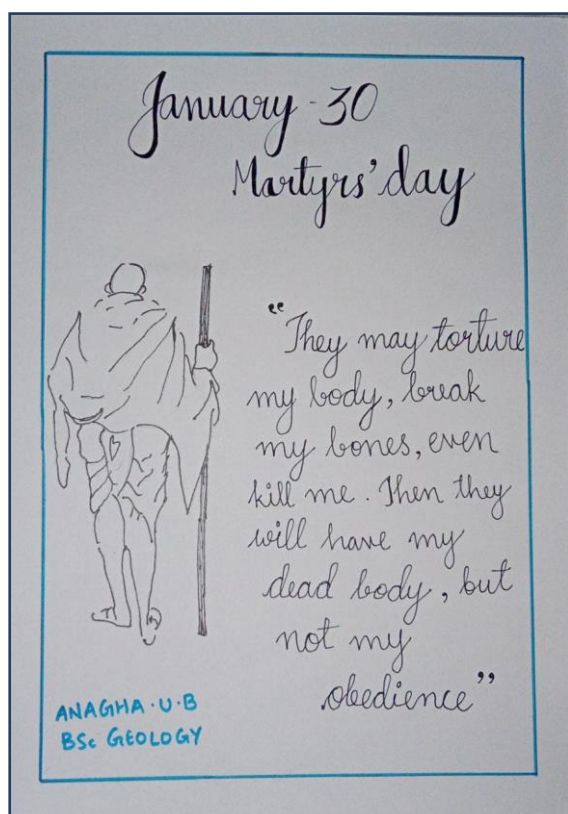

The college celebrated International Women's day and conducted various programmes like Poster Making, Exhibition, Debate, writing on My Insights on women and invited talks.

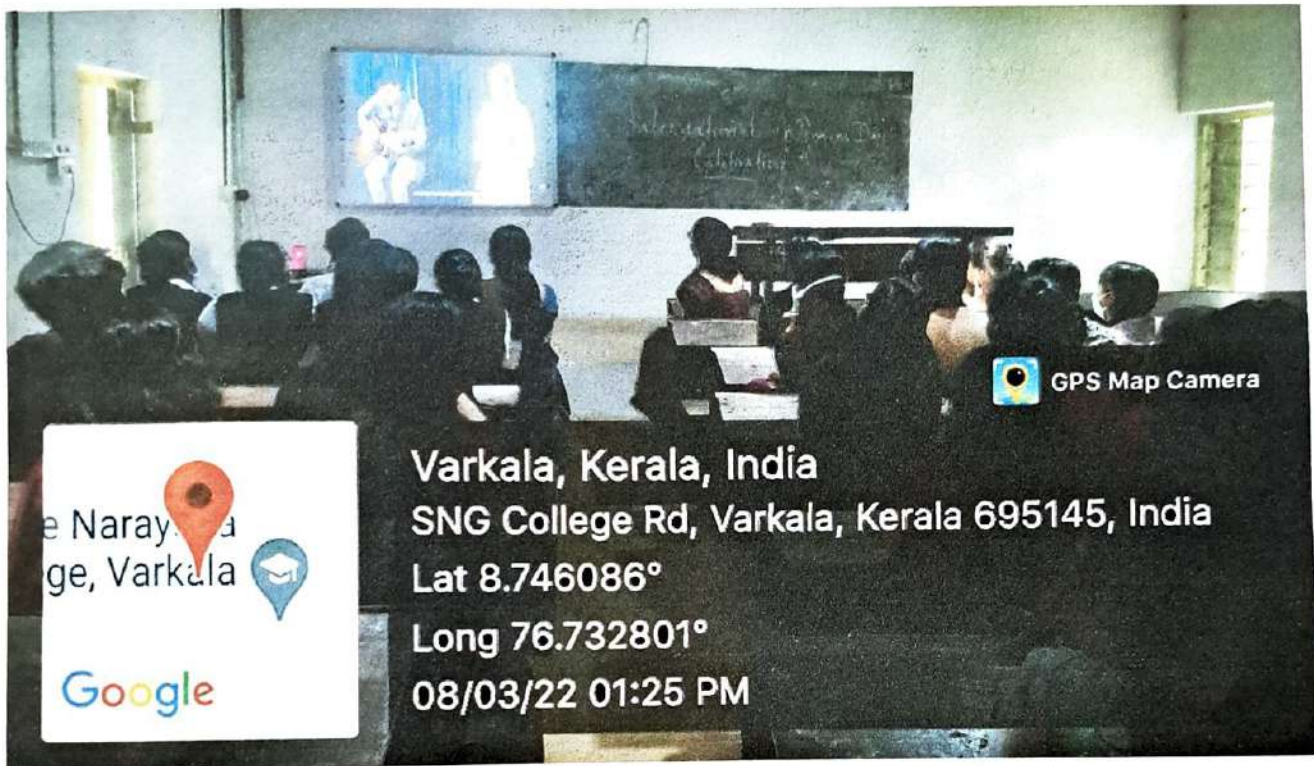
