








YOGA DAY CELEBRATIONS 21/06/2023

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS








N.S.S DAY 2023






CLEANING IN ADOPTED VILLAGE






Home Visit of Palliative Care Patients – 12/01/2024




BLOOD DONATION CAMP

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




HARVEST FEST

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
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Orientation on Opportunities in Commerce Education

In the **Instrumentation Room**, students were introduced to the working of pH meters, gel electrophoresis units, centrifuges, double distillation units, electronic weighing machines, image analyzers, water baths, BOD incubators, and autoclaves.

In the **Botany Lab**, plant specimens of Bryophytes, Pteridophytes, Gymnosperms, and angiosperms were displayed, along with seeds and their dispersal mechanisms. Economically important plant products, such as cereals, grains, nuts, and spices, were also exhibited. Special emphasis was placed on **millets**, with detailed displays of Sorghum, Pearl Millet, Finger Millet, and minor millets.
