
## 1. TEACHER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS




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aspects. The teachers were requested to pay more attention to the accuracy of internal assessment and organise more extension activities, workshops and seminars.


The feedback data showed that students are not still satisfied with the library facility and lab facility. The class room facility also needs improvement as per the analysis. The matter was discussed in the dept.


#### 2. DEPARTMENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS


